Information on Exam Reforms

Following protocols were initiated as exam reforms during pandemic COVID-19.

- 1. COVID-19 (RT-PCR) test was conducted for all the exam going students and staffs assigned for duties prior to examination.
- 2. Temperature was checked for the students and staff before entering examination hall.
- 3. Students were asked to sanitize hands before and after exams.
- 4. Students were instructed to wear masks throughout the examination.
- 5. Students were made to sit at a distance of 6 feet.
- 6. Invigilators were asked to wear masks, face shields and gloves during the sessions.
- 7. Separate rooms were maintained for COVID positive students and for those who had Influenza Like Illness (ILI) symptoms.
- 8. COVID positive students were asked to wear a PPE kit and also the Invigilator posted for the COVID positive student.
- 9. Social distancing was maintained during the scanning process of answer scripts.
- 10. Separate entry and exit were maintained to prevent criss crossing of students.
