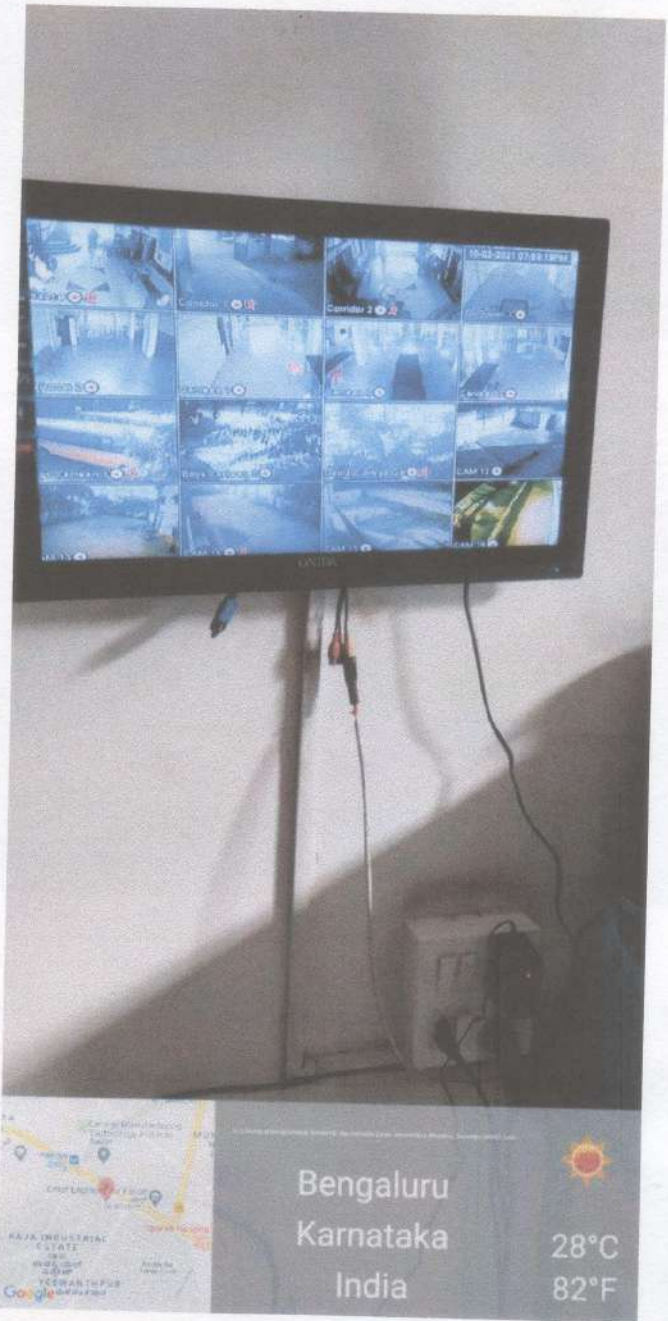

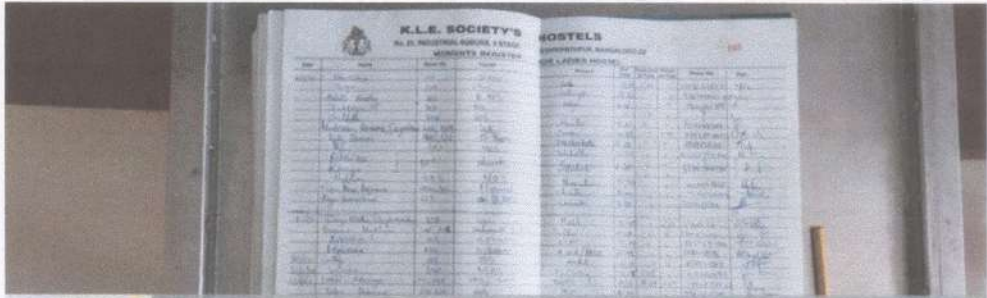
Hostel Warden in Charge of Girl's Hostel

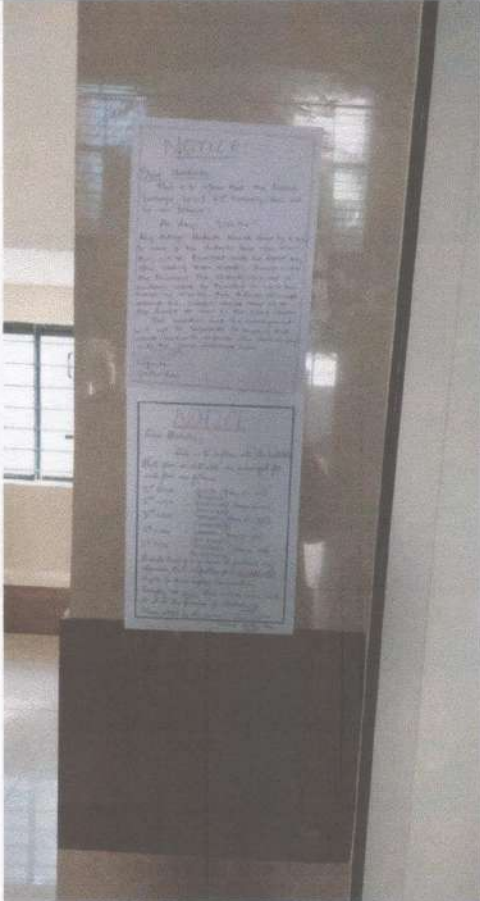

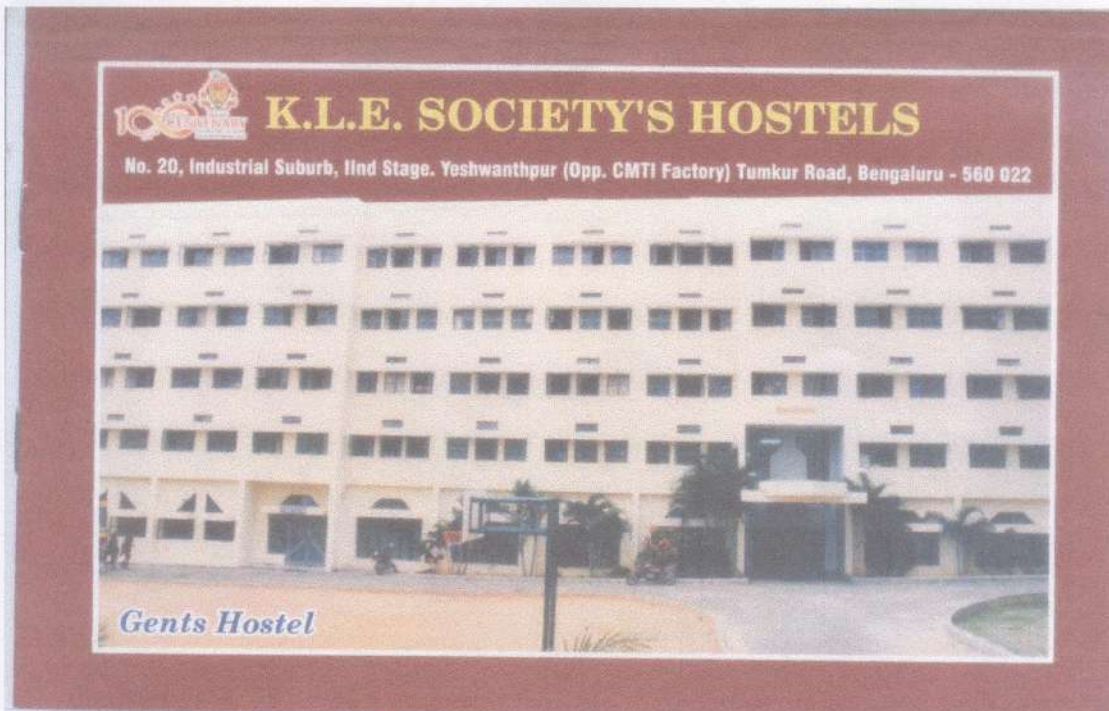

RULES AND REGULATIONS

HOSTEL RULES

1. Supervision & Control :

The supervision and control of the student residing in the hostels will rest with the Superintendent / Resident wardens.

2. Admission & allotment of Rooms :

- a) Hostel Seat accommodation is made purely at the discretion of the Superintendent and on condition that the student agrees to abide by all the Rules and regulations in this behalf. The Superintendent may refuse Hostel facilities without assigning any reason.
- b) Every student seeking admission in the Hostel should apply in the prescribed form to the Superintendent, K.L.E. Society's Hostels, Bengaluru. These forms can be obtained in the College Office or from the Hostel clerk.
- c) The name of student admitted to the hostels will be entered in a Register, together with the date of his / her admission.
- d) Once a student has been admitted to the hostel, he / she will not be permitted to leave it till the end of term. If, however he / she leaves hostel in contravention of this rule, he / she will be liable to pay the rent and rent and other establishment charges at stipulated rates.

- e) Rooms to be allotted by the Superintendent / Warden, taking into consideration the priority of the application, seniority in the course of studies, result at examination held earlier and other such criteria at his discretion. No allotment will be made to student who have not paid their College tuition and other fees.

- f) The Principal may refuse admission to the hostel to any applicant, at his discretion, or remove a student from the hostel at any time, as a disciplinary measure.

Hostel furniture allotted to particular room should not be removed at any other place. Surprise inspection will be carried out in this connection and if it is found that the furniture allotted to particular room is carried to any other place, the same will be viewed seriously and disciplinary action will be taken against the concerned student including removal from the hostel.

3. Responsibility for Student's Property :

The hostel authorities do not hold themselves responsible for any loss of property of students residing in the hostel.

Students are advised, in their own interest, not to keep money and other valuables in their rooms. They may deposit all sums of money, not immediately required by them, for their expenses in the Local Branch of any Bank or in the Post Office Saving Bank.

Students must provide themselves with their own locks for their rooms in the hostel and for the lockers that are provided for them.
